GETTING YOUR CHILD BAPTISED

You can have your child baptised at St. Paul's if

You live in the parish; or

You regularly attend worship at St. Paul's.

If you do not live in the parish nor attend St. Paul's you may still be able to have your child baptised at the church but you will have to obtain the permission of the vicar in whose parish you live, and you will have to give the reasons why you wish the baptism to take place at St. Paul's and not in your local parish church.

If you are not sure which parish you are in then the website www.achurchnearyou.com will help you find this out.

Booking the Baptism

You will be asked to attend church four times before we book the date of the baptism. Baptism is a service which marks someone becoming a member of the Church and so it is appropriate that you have attended church in the weeks leading up to the baptism.

Baptisms usually happen at 11.30am on the first Sunday of the month. However if you have good reasons for wanting another time we will consider this.

Godparents

When considering who to choose as Godparents please remember that they must be baptised themselves.
