**The Collect:**

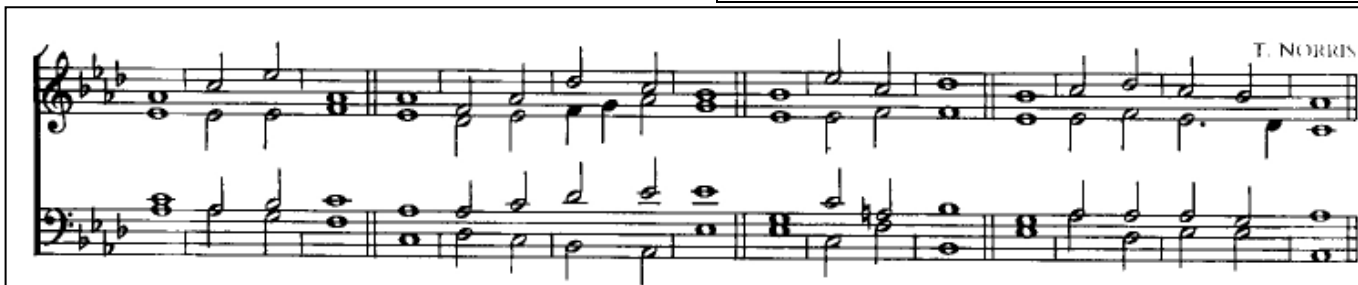
O God,
