*Jesus appoints seventy followers and sends them on a mission, with strict and specific instructions on how to conduct themselves and deal with people.*

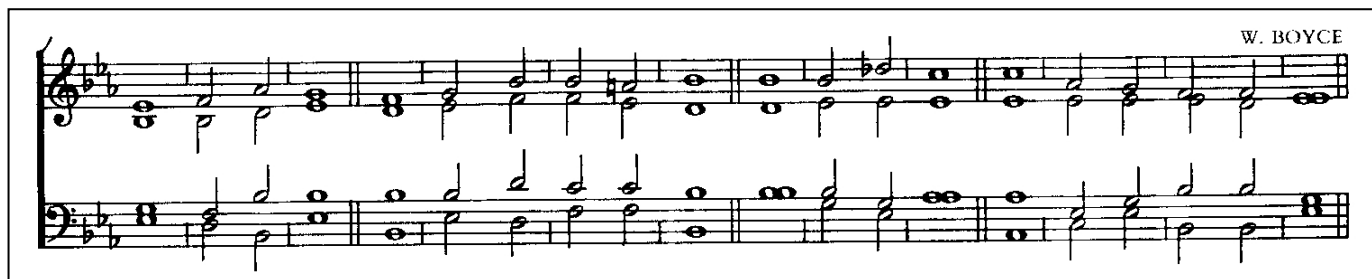
### Psalm: 30
