Paul defends himself against those would-be leaders who claim to be better than him in spiritual gifts. Paul is forced to defend himself – even boast a little - but in the end claims that his weaknesses are what mark him out as a child of God.

Jesus and his disciples bring their message to Jesus’ home town, but find a level of unbelief that is in direct contrast to the other towns and villages of Palestine.
